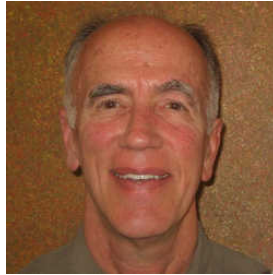




The Association for Nepal and Himalayan Studies is pleased to announce

The James Fisher Prize for First Books on the Himalayan Region



In honor of the scholarly contributions of Dr. James Fisher to scholarship on the region, the Association of Nepal and Himalayan Studies is soliciting books for the newly created James Fisher Prize for First Books on the Himalayan Region. Books must have been published in the past two years prior to the deadline of May 1, 2017. Single or co-authored academic books written in English are accepted; edited volumes, fiction, or non-English language books are not eligible. This prize is for first books only.

The award recipient will receive a \$250 prize from ANHS. All submissions will be archived at the ANHS library at the Kathmandu Resource Center in Kathmandu, Nepal. A committee will determine the awardee and may choose to designate no winner in any given year if no appropriate submissions are received. Applicants in all disciplines are encouraged to apply.

Submissions must be received by May 1, 2017.
